STRANGER THINGS SERIES RECAP

All too often, it's easy for us to misunderstand what the Bible teaches about heaven and hell, angels and demons, and the afterlife. "Stranger Things" is a four-week message series that examines if hell is a real place, what heaven is like, and even learn what happens one minute after we die.

SERMON SUMMARY

What happens one minute after you die? Where do you go? Once you die, do you go to sleep until final judgment and then get sent to heaven or hell? Or do you instantly go to heaven or hell? Do you become an angel or a ghost? Find out what Jesus teaches about the afterlife and what those have chosen to accept Jesus can expect.

SCRIPTURE FROM THE SERMON

James 4:14; Luke 16:19-3; Hebrews 9:27-28; Luke 23:43; 2 Corinthians 5:8; James 4:13-17; Matthew 6:19-20

STARTING THE DISCUSSION

If your group needs a "jumpstart" to get going, use the icebreaker or a simple open-ended question such as "What stood out to you most about this week's sermon?"

ICEBREAKER SUGGESTION

As a group can you name all 50 U.S. states in one minute? Give it a try and find out!

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. What are your thoughts of the parable of the rich man and the beggar from Luke 16?
2. What do you think about an immediate and permanent destination after death?
3. Why do you feel God allows us to make the choice of where to spend eternity before death and not after death?
4. How do you feel about the concept of investing yourself today in what will matter for eternity?
5. What is one way you can start investing for eternity?

*Leaders Note: If people in your group are having trouble thinking of anything for question 5 use prompts such as: Who would you share Jesus with? Where would you serve? What relationship would you mend? Would you go on a mission trip?
