**Sermon: Historic Identity: Can God Use Me for Big Things?**

**KEY POINTS:**

- The impact of your life is determined not by your ability or history but by God's call.
- To do great things for God, we must relinquish our wills and be willing to say, "let it be me.:"
- When God calls you to a task, he will provide both a reason to believe and a relationship to sustain you.
