Who Are Social Influencers for Jesus? Part II

KEY POINTS:

- The Samaritan woman was the least likely person to influence others for Jesus, yet she did. You can too.
- Jesus didn't avoid her past or judge her for it. Rather, he allowed her to use all of who she was to influence others to come to him.
- The discussion Jesus wants to have with us and wants us to have with others is not about theology but about his identity as the Savior of the world.

QUESTIONS:

After reading the essay, what influencer do you think could have for Jesus?
